## VILLAGE OF NAVARRE STARK COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 5-2024

## AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW VILLAGE MUNICIPAL REGULATION 76.11, LIMITING PARKING ON CANAL STREET WEST

Whereas, one of the very busiest intersections in the Village is that of Canal Street and Main Street, which includes U. S. Rte. 62 and Ohio State Rte. 21, and

Whereas, said intersection is used by many large vehicles, including fifty-three foot semi tractor-trailers, many of which make right angle turns either to the right or left, and

Whereas, motor vehicles parked on the south side of Canal Street West between Sisterhen Court SW and Main Street make such right angle turns very difficult and unsafe, and such parking also reduces sight distance for drivers approaching the Canal-Main intersection,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and enacts new Village Codified Municipal Regulation 76.11, which shall read as follows:

"Section 76.11- Parking on Canal Street West

Motor vehicles shall not park or stand on the south side of Canal Street West, between the intersection of Canal Street and Main Street and Sisterhen Court SW."
