Section 2 - This ordinance is declared to be an emergency, as being for the safety, health, and welfare of the residents of and visitors to the Village of Navarre, as it is required by Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 705.18, in order for the Village to operate, and Village Council waives the three reading requirement for ordinances, so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
