Whereas, fairness dictates that new police officers, as a consequence of the Village of Navarre committing to the cost of training, agree to a partial reimbursement of up to half of said costs, pro-rated depending on length of service with the Village,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows -

That the Village of Navarre, through its Police Chief, may enter into agreements with new police officer hires, for partial reimbursement of the cost of training, in a form to be approved by the Village Solicitor.
