RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO  
AGREEMENT WITH, AND OTHERWISE COOPERATE WITH,  
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WITH RESPECT TO  
IMPROVEMENTS TO U. S. ROUTE 62 WITHIN VILLAGE LIMITS  
(ODOT PID # 94136, D04 MCRO FY2024)

Whereas, Village Council met in an open meeting on June 5, 2023, to consider cooperation with Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), with respect to proposed improvements by ODOT on U. S. Rte. 62 within the Village of Navarre, and

Whereas, the Village of Navarre and ODOT have identified the need for the following described project – Microsurfacing of U. S. Rte. 62 within the Village of Navarre,

Now Therefore, be it Resolved by Village Council as follows:

Section 1 - Project Description

The project is known as Microsurfacing of US 62 in the Village of Navarre.

Section 2 - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the Village of Navarre gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described Microsurfacing project.

Section 3 - Cooperation Statement

The Village of Navarre, and all of its officials, shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described Microsurfacing project as follows:

The State of Ohio shall assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of all of the costs of the above described Microsurfacing project.

The Village of Navarre agrees to pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the Village of Navarre which are determined by the State of Ohio and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Microsurfacing project.

Section 4 - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The Village of Navarre agrees that all right-of-way required for the described Microsurfacing project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State of Ohio and federal regulations. The Village of Navarre also understands and acknowledges that right-of way costs include eligible utility costs.

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## Section 5 - Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Microsurfacing project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Village of Navarre shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Microsurfacing project in accordance with all applicable State of Ohio and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Microsurfacing Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.


## Section 6 - Authority to Sign

The Village Administrator and Mayor of the Village of Navarre are hereby empowered, on behalf of the Village of Navarre, to enter into all contracts with the Director of ODOT, which are necessary to complete the above described Microsurfacing project.


## Section 7 - Declaration of Emergency

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency resolution to expedite the aforesaid highway project, and to promote highway safety; thus time is of the essence to give Village of Navarre officials authority to enter into necessary contracts with the Director of ODOT. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



