RESOLUTION RENUMBERING ORDINANCE 2-2023 (PASSED
MAY 15, 2023) TO ORDINANCE 8-2023

Whereas, on March 20, 2023, Village Council passed Ordinance 2-2023, relating to truck routes in the Village, and

Whereas, on May 15, 2023, Village Council passed another ordinance bearing the number 2-2023, relating to chickens and domestic fowl, and

Whereas, the numbering of the second 2-2023 ordinance was an error, but both ordinances bearing that number were validly passed by Village Council and signed by the Mayor, and


Whereas, the number 8-2023 is unused, and Village Council believes that renumbering the second Ordinance 2-2023 to 8-2023 will reduce confusion,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows --

- (1) The second Ordinance 2-2023 shall be re-numbered Ordinance 8-2023.
- (2) The Village Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to interlineate the new 8-2023 number onto the original of the second Ordinance 2-2023 maintained in the Village's official record of ordinances and resolutions.
- (3) This Resolution is passed with only one reading, as the underlying ordinance has already been considered and passed by Village Council, and this Resolution is remedial in nature only.


