

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO EXTENSION
OF AGREEMENT WITH CITY OF MASSILLON LAW DIRECTOR
FOR PROSECUTION OF CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES
OCCURRING WITHIN VILLAGE OF NAVARRE

Whereas, the Village of Navarre and the City of Massillon Law Director entered into a written contract for the year 2020, whereby the Law Director's office acted as the Village Prosecutor with respect to criminal and traffic offenses occurring within the Village of Navarre, and this contract was renewed for the years 2021 and 2022, and

Whereas, the Village of Navarre desires that said contract be renewed for the calendar year 2023 for the sum of \$14,000 and other consideration recited in the proposed 2023 contract, and

Whereas, the Village Solicitor has reviewed and approved the form of said 2023 contract, and


Whereas, the Massillon Law Director's office has continued to provide services after December 31, 2022, at the request of the Village Solicitor, and the 2023 contract should be deemed effective January 1, 2023, and

Whereas, the Village Solicitor has determined, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 2938.13 that the Massillon Law Director's office is an appropriate attorney to whom prosecutorial duties may be delegated,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows –

That the Village of Navarre shall enter into a contract with the City of Massillon Law Director, in the form already approved by the Village Solicitor, that an emergency exists as the Village needs the Massillon Law Director's uninterrupted assistance, thus obviating any requirement of three readings, and that the Mayor of Navarre is authorized to execute and deliver said contract on behalf of the Village of Navarre, immediately after passage of this Resolution.


