

RESOLUTION FOR PAYMENT OF VILLAGE BILLS WHEN OR BEFORE DUE

Whereas, the Village has hired a new fiscal officer, and

Whereas, the prior vacancy had caused a disruption of the Village's timely payment of its bills and claims, and

Whereas, Village Council voted to temporarily authorize payment of such bills and claims without prior Village Council approval, until a new fiscal officer has been appointed and started working in that position, and

Whereas, Village Council deems it prudent to authorize the new fiscal officer to pay bills and claims received by the Village when due, and thereafter for her to present them to Village Council for approval, such as is done by most other political subdivisions in the State of Ohio, and

Now Therefore, Village Council, having considered the above at a regularly scheduled public meeting, Resolves to Authorize the Fiscal Officer to pay Village bills on or before their due date, and to sign checks or make other form of payment necessary to make such payments, without prior approval of Village Council, provided that all bills and claims are submitted to Village Council at its next meeting for approval, and further provided that any bill and claim in the amount of \$20,000 or more shall require Village Council approval before payment, and further providing that the Mayor or Village Administrator may, in each such officer's sole discretion require that a bill or claim in any sum be laid before Village Council before payment.


