Whereas, the Village has continuously participated in an electric aggregation program, pursuant to Ordinance 2-2003, and

The Village of Navarre has an interest in seeing that its residents and its own accounts receive uninterrupted electric service,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows -

That the Village of Navarre, through its Mayor and/or Village Administrator may enter into an agreement with Buckeye Energy Brokers, Inc. for aggregation consulting services and any other required services related to electric utility deregulation and ratifying any such services heretofore performed.

This Resolution is deemed an emergency by Council, as time is of the essence to prevent interruption of electric service to the Village's residents, and to procure a favorable electric price structure in a period of extremely volatile energy pricing.
