AMENDMENT TO CODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEGAUNEE

CHAPTER 1

The City of Negaunee ORDAINS:

That Chapter 156.179, Signs, of the Codified Ordinances of Negaunee, Michigan, shall be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

REPEALER

**Chapter 156.179 of the Codified Ordinances of Negaunee, Michigan, and any other ordinance, resolution, order or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of these Amendments are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. The repeal date shall be the effective date of the following Amendments.**

AMENDMENT

Chapter 156.179(F), Regulations Based Upon Sign Type, Sidewalk signs, of the Codified Ordinances of Negaunee, Michigan, shall be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

(F)(1) All displays, signs, merchandise or other temporary fixtures must be removed daily from the sidewalk at the close of the business' daily operations or by 10:00PM, whichever is earlier, and no display may be placed on the sidewalk before 7:00AM. See Neg. Ord. 93.10(B) Business District related display regulations.

(F)(4) At all times of the year, sidewalk signs shall be placed directly in front of the business and shall allow a minimum of five (5') feet of unobstructed sidewalk for pedestrians. Sidewalk signs shall not be placed within 25 feet of an intersection, measured perpendicularly from the intersecting curb. During the winter months, the sidewalk shall be completely clear of snow prior to placement and sidewalk signs shall not be placed on snowbanks. See Neg. Ord. 93.10(A) Business District related sidewalk use regulations.
