ORDINANCE NO. 01-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 112.05(H) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF NEWBURG ESTABLISHING A PROVISIONAL OPERATOR LICENSE FEE AND TERM

SECTION I. PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Statute 125.17(5) establishes a Provisional Operator license with a fee not to exceed \$15 with a set term expiring in 60 days after its issuance or when a license is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board having previously adopted Section 112.05(H) of the Municipal Code of Newburg set the license fee at \$15 with a term of 30 days; and

WHEREAS, the Village code cannot supersede and needs to comply with State Statute;

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Newburg, Wisconsin, does hereby recreate Section 112.05(H) of the Municipal Code to read:

SECTION II. REPEAL AND RECREATE

112.05 LICENSE FEES.

(H) Provisional operator's licenses: \$15 for up to 60 days, as provided in Wis. Stats. Section 125.17(5).

SECTION III. MISCELLANEOUS

SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provision, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
