

## **VILLAGE OF NEWBURG**

### **ORDINANCE NO. 02-2016**

#### **AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 7.15(9) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF NEWBURG REQUIRING POLICE OFFICERS AUTHORIZED TO ACCEPT DEPOSITS TO POST BOND**

##### SECTION I. PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Village Board having previously adopted Section 7.15(9) of the Municipal Code of Newburg requiring any Police Officer authorized to accept deposits shall qualify by taking the oath and filing an official bond in the sum of \$100 as provided by Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, such bonding is no longer available to be purchased on the open market for the above stated purpose,

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Newburg, Wisconsin, does hereby recreate Section 7.15(9) of the Municipal Code to read:

##### SECTION II. REPEAL AND RECREATE

###### **7.15(9) DISPOSITION OF DEPOSITS.**

Any police officer accepting deposits or forfeited penalties under this chapter shall deliver them to the Washington County Clerk of Courts, the Ozaukee County Clerk of the Courts or Mid-Moraine Municipal Court Clerk respectively, within 20 days after receipt, except for parking forfeitures which shall be turned over to the Village of Newburg Treasurer.

##### SECTION III. MISCELLANEOUS

SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provision, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

##### SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
