

## VILLAGE OF NEWBURG

### ORDINANCE NO. 06-2016

#### AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 130.049(A)(2) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF NEWBURG ESTABLISHING THE DEFINITION OF TRASH WITHIN THE BURNING REGULATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEWBURG

##### SECTION I. PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Village Board having previously adopted Section 130.049(A)(2) of the Municipal Code of Newburg Establishing the Definition of Trash within the Burning Regulations for the Village of Newburg; and

WHEREAS, to further clarify that the definition of Trash does not include leaves, as set in Section 130.049(A)(2), which is in conflict with the allowance of Leaf Burning, as allowed in Section 130.049(C),

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Newburg, Wisconsin, does hereby recreate Section 130.049(A)(2) of the Municipal Code to read:

##### SECTION II. REPEAL AND RECREATE

#### **130.049(A)(2)**

(2) *Trash defined.* For the purpose of this section, the following definition shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

**TRASH.** Rubbish, grass, plastic, construction waste, paper products, industrial waste or any other type of debris.

##### SECTION III. MISCELLANEOUS

SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provision, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
