ORDINANCE NO. 10-2017

# AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE CHAPTER 161 ENTITLED FORFEITURES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF NEWBURG 

SECTION I. PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Village of Newburg desires to consolidate all forfeitures, fees and charges into one Chapter of the Municipal Code for more efficient oversight and review,

NOW THERFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Newburg, Wisconsin, does here create Chapter 161 of the Municipal Code to read:

## SECTION II. REPEAL AND RECREATE

161.01 STATEMENT OF PURPOSES. All forfeitures, fees, charges and other fixed sources of revenue paid to the Village of Newburg, and to related organizations whose budgets are reviewed and/or approved by the Village Board, shall be listed in this chapter, except special assessments and charges, utility and property tax rates set by annual budget, certain recreation program and other fees and charges which change frequently due to programmatic variation, some time and material charges, and other incidental fees.

1) This listing is designed to provide citizens, staff and elected officials with a single reference document for most municipal charges.
2) The intent of this comprehensive listing is to facilitate annual review of forfeitures, fees, charges and other revenue sources, to assure that, to the extent feasible, users of specific municipal services continue to bear the cost of materials, operational costs, related outside charges to the Village, staff review time, staff paperwork-related costs, and related indirect costs. To the extent feasible, reviews shall occur prior to or concurrent with the budgetary process for adoption of appropriate revisions by the Village Board effective either January 1 or July 1 of each year.
3) It shall be the policy of the Village of Newburg that, to the extent practical, user costs not be subsidized by property taxes or otherwise shifted to non-related income sources, and that there be progressive movement toward municipal service users paying $100 \%$ of related costs. Once established, user fees are intended to remain at $100 \%$ of costs. Where feasible, cost analyses shall be prepared on occasion to determine that user fees are neither too low to recover the cost of service delivery, nor serve as a subsidy for other cost centers.
161.02 BOND SCHEDULE. (1) Standard Penalty. The range for deposit amounts for municipal ordinance violations is shown following the offense description, municipal code chapter or ordinance number. If any offense description does not indicate a specific deposit amount, the general deposit amount for the ordinance chapter or number shall apply. The bond schedule for said violations is as follows:

(2) Juvenile Penalty. (a) Definition. "Juvenile" means a person who is 12 years of age or older but less than 17 years of age.
(b) Penalty. Any juvenile who violates any provision of this Code or any rule or regulation adopted or issued pursuant hereto or any provision of any code adopted herein by reference, upon conviction of such violation, shall be subject to imposition of any of the dispositions set forth in Sections 938.343 and 938.344 , Wis. Stats., in accordance with the provisions of those sections. Any juvenile who violates a condition of a dispositional order under Sections 938.343 or 938.344, Wis. Stats., upon adjudication of such violation, shall be subject to imposition of any of the sanctions set forth in Section 938.355(6)(d), Wis. Stats., in accordance with the provisions of that section.

161.04 WARRANT OR COMMITMENT ORDER SERVICE FEE. (1) Authority. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stats. §§ 814.70, 814.705, and 814.71.
(2) Purpose. On November 18, 2009 the Attorney General for the State of Wisconsin rendered an opinion, identified as OAG-8-09, that a municipal plaintiff is allowed to tax costs against the defendant in municipal court for actual service or execution by its municipal personnel of each warrant or commitment order issued by its municipal court in a legal action. The purpose of this Ordinance is to implement the authority recognized by the Wisconsin Statutes and the Attorney General.
(3) Service Fees. Pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stats., $\S \S 814.70,814.705$ and 814.71 the Village of Newburg Police Department shall charge a service fee of $\$ 35$ when the Village police serve a warrant or commitment order upon a person. The person served with the warrant or commitment order shall be responsible for the payment of the warrant or commitment order service fee. The service fee may be collected as a court cost through the court.
(4) Multiple Warrants. The Village of Newburg Police Department shall charge a separate fee for each warrant or commitment order served on a person.
(5) Disposition of Fees. Upon collection by the court, all warrant or commitment order service fees shall be forwarded by the court to the Village Treasurer.
(6) Severability. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid, illegal, unenforceable, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. Furthermore, the relevant court of competent jurisdiction is authorized to substitute for the provision at issue a valid and enforceable provision as similar as possible to the provision at issue.
(7) Implementation. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village inconsistent with or contrary to this Ordinance are hereby repealed. The Village Clerk is authorized and directed to take all action necessary to incorporate this Ordnance into the Village Code of Ordinances without further authorization.
161.05 Conflicting Fees. It is the intent of the Village that this Chapter shall contain all fees for the Village. In the event that any fee recited in another Chapter conflicts with the fee recited in this Chapter 161, the fee recited in Chapter 161 shall govern.

## SECTION III. MISCELLANEOUS

SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provision, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

## SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
