**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE CODE OF ETHICS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEWBURG
PURSUANT TO APPLICABLE WISCONSIN STATUTES**

1 WHEREAS, the Village Board has previously established a Code of Ethics; and

3 WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined it to be in the best interests of the Village
4 to add penalty provisions to the Code of Ethics.

5
6 NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Newburg, Wisconsin, does hereby
7 amend Section 30.06 of the Municipal Code, regarding a Code of Ethics for the Village of
8 Newburg, by adopting the following:

10 **SECTION I. §30.06 is hereby amended as follows:**

12 §30.06 CODE OF ETHICS

14 (H) *Penalty and Sanctions.* Violation of any provision of this subchapter may constitute
15 a cause for suspension, removal from office or employment, or other disciplinary action. The
16 Village Board may impose a forfeiture pursuant to §19.59(3)(f), Wis. Stats., equal to the
17 expense of the ethics proceedings, except that the forfeiture shall not exceed \$1,000 for each
18 offense.

20 **SECTION II. MISCELLANEOUS**

22 *SEVERABILITY.* The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If
23 any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be
24 invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or
25 portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other
26 provision, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall
27 remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the
28 provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

33 **SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE**

35 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as
36 provided by law.
