A RESOLUTION / ORDINANCE
CREATING A COMMUNITY CENTER COMMISSION

1 WHEREAS, the Village of Newburg has various citizen committees and
2 commissions created for the purpose of citizen involvement and input in village affairs;
3 and
4

5 WHEREAS, the “It’s a Beautiful Day in Newburg Community Center,” is a
6 relatively new facility currently under the scope of the Department of Public Works,
7 however is not itself a “park;” and
8

9 WHEREAS, the Parks Commission is tasked with developing plans for the
10 acquisition, development, maintenance, and operation of village parks, which does not
11 by definition include the community center; and
12

13 WHEREAS, in order to comply with donor requirements, carry out specific plans
14 for events, and overall plan for the future of the community center; not therefore
15

16 BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees amends village ordinance §30.04 with
17 the following addition:

19 §32.04 BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

22 (G) Community Center Commission.

- 23 (1) The Community Center Commission shall consist of five members,
24 including two Village Trustees and three citizen members. The Village
25 Trustees and the citizen members shall be appointed by the Village
26 President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board. The Trustees
27 shall serve one-year terms and citizen members staggered three-year
28 terms. The DPW Superintendent shall serve as an advisor to the
29 commission.

31 (2) The Community Center Commission shall in coordination with the
32 DPW Superintendent, develop recommendations for the maintenance
33 and future use planning of the community center, and shall be
34 responsible for planning community center events not otherwise taken
35 up by village staff, and for coordinating volunteer activities necessary
36 for the survival of the community center in the interest of the village
37 residents at large.
