

**AMENDING CHAPTER 73 OF THE ORDINANCES TO CREATE POLICY REGARDING
VEHICLE PARKING IN EXCESS OF 48 HOURS
(As Amended)**

1 WHEREAS, The residents and business operators of Newburg shall have the ability to
2 enjoy use of the public roadways without undue interference by vehicles stored for extended
3 periods of time on those roadways; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles in front of homes or businesses on Main Street for
6 longer than 48 hours can become a concern for those who recognize the displacement; and

8 WHEREAS, the Newburg Police Department has provided options to the Administrator
9 and Board of Trustees for the creation of an ordinance prohibiting parking in for an excessive
10 period of time which would be an addition to Schedule I of the Parking Restrictions and for which
11 violation would carry a fine of \$20.00.

13 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees ordains amending the
14 municipal code as follows:

16 **§73 PARKING SCHEDULES**

18 Schedule I – Parking Restrictions

21 (L) *Parking in excess of 48 hours prohibited.* Parking on Main Street or in a municipally-
22 owned or operated parking lot for a period longer than 48 consecutive hours without movement is
23 prohibited unless express permission from the Newburg Police Department is granted. For the
24 purposes of this section, a minimum distance of 12 feet shall be the measurement used to
25 determine whether or not a vehicle has been moved.
