## AMENDING CHAPTER 73 OF THE ORDINANCES TO CREATE POLICY REGARDING VEHICLE PARKING IN EXCESS OF 48 HOURS

(As Amended)

1 WHEREAS, The residents and business operators of Newburg shall have the ability to enjoy use of the public roadways without undue interference by vehicles stored for extended 2 3 periods of time on those roadways; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles in front of homes or businesses on Main Street for 6 longer than 48 hours can become a concern for those who recognize the displacement; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the Newburg Police Department has provided options to the Administrator 9 and Board of Trustees for the creation of an ordinance prohibiting parking in for an excessive period of time which would be an addition to Schedule I of the Parking Restrictions and for which 10 violation would carry a fine of \$20.00. 11 12 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees ordains amending the 13 municipal code as follows: 14 15 16 §73 PARKING SCHEDULES 17 Schedule I – Parking Restrictions 18 19 20 (L) Parking in excess of 48 hours prohibited. Parking on Main Street or in a municipally-21 owned or operated parking lot for a period longer than 48 consecutive hours without movement is 22 23 prohibited unless express permission from the Newburg Police Department is granted.
