AMENDING CHAPTERS 70 AND 72 OF THE ORDINANCES TO ELIMINATE HEAVY TRUCK ROUTES ON VILLAGE ROADWAYS

(12) Salisbury Street; and

WHEREAS, Roads thaw in the spring from both the top and the bottom and water can become trapped in a way that can considerably weaken pavement in a short amount of time when put under pressure; and	
WHEREAS, the Village Board historically has had the authority and right to impose seasonal weight limits to village roadways; and	
WHEREAS, allowing the Village President the authority to impose seasonal weight limits village roadways will reduce the likelihood of damage that could occur while awaiting board eliberation and approval during Wisconsin's often fast seasonal swings in temperature; and	
WHEREAS, the Village Board is rightfully concerned that non-local heavy truck traffic could be unnecessarily wearing down village roadways; and	
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees ordains amending the municipal code as follows:	
§72 TRAFFIC SCHEDULES	
Schedule I – HEAVY TRAFFIC ROUTES	
(A) Routes designated. The following streets and parts of streets within the village are hereby designated heavy traffic routes:	
— (1) C.T.H. I;	
(2) C.T.H. MY;	
— (3) (1) C.T.H. Y;	
— (4) Carmody Court;	
— (5) Congress Drive;	
— (6) Congress Street;	
— (7) Division Street;	
— (8) Franklin Street;	
— (9) Hickory Road;	
— (10) Municipal Drive;	
— (11) (2) S.T.H. 33;	

(13) Shady Lane.		
(B) Travel prohibited. No vehicle, except a motor bus, which is not equipped with pneumatic tires or has a combined vehicle load weight exceeding 10,000 pounds shall be operated or moved on any street or alley not a part of the heavy traffic route designated in division (A) above, except for the purpose of obtaining orders for moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from a place of business or residence facing thereon, provided that in no event shall the weight of the vehicle and load on such other street exceed the limitations of Wis. Stats. §§ 348.15 and 348.16(3).		
(B) Class "B" highways designated. Pursuant to §348.16, Wis. Stats., the highways maintained by the Village are designated Class "B" highways. No person shall operate any vehicle or combination of vehicles imposing wheel, axle, group of axles, or gross weight on any Village highway which exceeds 60% of the weight limitations for Class "A" highways as set forth in §348.15(3)(c), Wis. Stats.		
(C) Signs. The Director of Public Works, upon the recommendation of the Police Chief, shall cause to be secured and erected appropriate signs to give notice of the heavy traffic routes.		
§ 70.04 SPECIAL AND SEASONAL WEIGHT LIMITATIONS.		
The Village Board President shall have the authority to impose special or seasonal weight limits to prevent injury to the roadway of any highway, bridge, or culvert within the jurisdiction of the village or for the safety of users thereof, and shall be responsible for erecting signs giving notice thereof in accordance with Wis. Stats. § 349.16. Such temporary gross weight limitations, set by the Village President, shall not be less than five tons.
