

**CITY OF O'FALLON, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 4373**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 30, 31, AND 32 OF THE O'FALLON CITY CODE
REGARDING CITY ADMINISTRATION, CITY OFFICERS, PUBLIC SAFETY, AND
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed portions of Chapters 30, 31, and 32 of the O'Fallon City Code and have determined that certain amendments are necessary and appropriate to reflect current organizational structure, administrative practices, and operational needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments provide clarification regarding City Council and committee procedures, electronic attendance requirements, administrative succession, public safety administration, and the establishment of Emergency Medical Services as a standalone department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that adoption of these amendments promotes efficient municipal operations and serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of O'Fallon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS.

The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 30.

Chapter 30 is amended to establish committee agenda procedures, clarify committee consideration of agenda items, require video participation for remote attendance, and make related administrative revisions.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 31.

Chapter 31 is amended to revise Acting City Administrator provisions, update Director of Public Safety responsibilities to include 911 Dispatch, and make related administrative revisions.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 32.

Chapter 32 is amended to establish the Emergency Medical Services Department, create the EMS Chief position, establish EMS service fee provisions, remove duplicative EMS references from Fire Department provisions, and make related administrative revisions.

SECTION 5. ATTACHMENT INCORPORATED.

The document entitled "Officers Code Updates" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference shall constitute the official amendments to Chapters 30, 31, and 32 of the O'Fallon City Code adopted by this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
