

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2003-02 TO DESIGNATE THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF OLIVE HILL AS CODE ENFORCEMENT & APPEALS BOARD

WHEREAS, it is the intent of KRS 65.8801 through KRS 65.8839 to protect, promote and improve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens residing within the City by issuing remedial orders and impose fines in order to provide an equitable, expeditious, effective, and inexpensive method of ensuring compliance with the ordinances in force within the City of Olive Hill; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of KRS 65.8801 through KRS 65.8839 to provide an additional or supplemental means of obtaining compliance with local government ordinances, and nothing contained therein shall prohibit the enforcement of local government ordinances by any other means authorized by law.

WHEREAS, the City of Olive Hill enacted Ordinance 2003-02 establishing a Code Enforcement Board to adopt rules and regulations; issue remedial orders; impose fines; ensure compliance; provide notice of violations; conduct hearings; take testimony under oath; to make findings of fact; subpoena violators, witnesses and evidence at hearings; and issuing final orders.

WHEREAS, the City deems it best to consolidate and place the powers of the Code Enforcement Board to the governing body to allow the City Council to more efficiently and effectively carry out those duties and powers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Olive Hill that the powers set forth in Ordinance 2003-02 are now vested in the City's legislative body, being the City Council. All hearings shall take place at the City Council's regularly scheduled meetings. Any provision of Ordinance 2003-02 not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The following provision shall take effect upon passage and publication.
