ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR ROADBLOCKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF OLIVE HILL, KY

WHEREAS, the City of Olive Hill sees a need to establish guidelines for fundraising roadblocks within the city limits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Olive Hill the following provision shall take effect upon passage and publication.

- 1. The Mayor may approve six and the City Council may approve six roadblocks for no more than twelve roadblocks per year.
- 2. All fundraising projects shall be non-profit organizations that benefit a large portion of the community.
- 3. No one under 18 years of age shall participate in roadblock activities.
- 4. Roadblocks shall be at two locations only.
- 5. Organizations desiring to set up a roadblock for fundraising must submit a written letter of request stating the purpose, date, starting time and ending time of the roadblock, and present proof of non-profit status. Proof being letter of designation.
- 6. No fundraising roadblock shall be held without written permission from the Chief of Police or Mayor.
- 7. All fundraising roadblocks applications shall be submitted by April 1st for 2017 calendar year and thereafter March 1st of every calendar year.
- 8. All fundraising roadblocks shall have large signs clearly stating the purpose of the roadblock
- 9. Any and all liability of activities for a fundraising roadblock shall rest with the organization hosting the fundraiser and not the City of Olive Hill, Kentucky.
- 10. Roadblock participants shall wear reflective vest.
- 11. Anyone in violation will no longer be eligible for a roadblock permit.

Any ordinance or portion to this ordinance in conflict or adverse to the provisions contained herein are hereby repealed and shall be rendered null and void upon the adoption of this ordinance.
