AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2004-03 & 2004-04 AMENDING THE CITY OF OLIVE HILL ZONING RESTRICTIONS AND ABOLOSHINGTHE HISTORICAL DISTRICTS AND BOARD OF ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD

WHEREAS, the City previously enacted Ordinances 2004-03 and 2004-04 which amended the City's Zoning Ordinance as it was intended to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Olive Hill;

WHEREAS, the City of Olive Hill has determined those zoning restrictions are unduly burdensome and require substantial financial obligations upon property owners and prospective businesses it those districts:

WHEREAS, the City of Olive Hill has determined these zoning amendments impede the City's economic opportunity and growth;

WHEREAS, the Board of Architectural Review is currently inactive without having appointed board members to enforce the restrictions set forth In Ordinances 2004-03 and 2004-04; and

WHEREAS, the City has additional zoning regulations sufficient to protect the safety and welfare of its citizens, businesses and patrons.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Olive Hill hereby repeals Ordinance 2004-03 and 2004-04 creating regulations for historical districts and creating a Board of Architectural Review.
