## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OLIVE HILL, KENTUCKY AMENDING ORDINANCE 1989-02 PERMITTING OWNERS TO REPLACE MOBILE HOMES CURRENTLY WITHIN CITY LIMITS WITH A NEWER MOBILE HOME WITHIN SIX MONTHS

WHEREAS, the City of Olive Hill, Kentucky enacted Ordinance 1989-02 which ordained that mobile homes shall not be set up on lots of land within the City limits other than those currently existing mobile home parks;

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of promoting the safety and welfare of its citizens as well as the aesthetic nature of the City;

WHEREAS, a number of citizens continue to reside in mobile homes existing when Ordinance 1989-02 was enacted; and

WHEREAS, forbidding citizens and property owners from replacing mobile homes currently existing within City limits would create a financial burden and economic stress.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Olive Hill as follows:

- 1. Mobile homes currently existing in City limits may be replaced with another, newer and aesthetically pleasing mobile home.
- 2. Any person wishing to replace a mobile home with a newer mobile home must first obtain a permit from the City.
- 3. The City may refuse to issue a permit if it deems the proposed mobile home is not in good condition or otherwise unfit to be within City limits.
- 4. The new mobile home must be replaced within six (6) months. The City will deny a permit in the event the mobile home is not replaced within this time.
- 5. All terms not in conflict with Ordinance 1989-02 shall remain in full force and effect.

  This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
