## Ordinance 2021-01

## ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUMBER OF CODE ENFORCMENT BOARD MEMBERS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Olive Hill deems it in the public interest to properly enforce the City Code by and through a Code Enforcement Board to provide a more effective and efficient means of enforcing its Ordinances;

**WHEREAS**, there currently exists in the City a Code Enforcement Board created pursuant to KRS 65.8801 to KRS 65.8839, et. seq. designating the Board to be composed of five members;

**WHEREAS**, the Code Enforcement Board and other civic organizations are comprised of volunteer citizens and it can become burdensome to fill boards with many individuals within the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City believes a Code Enforcement Board composed of three (3) members is sufficient to enforce City Ordinances.

## NIOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Olive Hill the following:

- 1. The Council for the City of Olive Hill, Kentucky hereby amends Ordinance 2003-05A and 2003-07 codified in §2.48.030(B) of the City Municipal Code to state as follows:
  - §2.48.030(B) *Creation and membership*. There is hereby created, pursuant to KRS 65.8801 to 65.8839 within the City, a Code Enforcement Board which shall be composed of three (3) members, all of whom shall be residents of the city for a period of at least one year prior to the creation of the Board and shall reside there throughout the term in office. Their successors shall have been residents of the city for a period of at least one year prior to their appointment and shall reside there throughout their term in office.
- 2. Any ordinance or portion to this ordinance in conflict or adverse to the provisions contained herein are herby repealed and shall be rendered null and void upon the adoption of this ordinance.
