AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF OREANA, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 51: GARBAGE

WHEREAS, the Village currently has Chapter 51 establishing garbage and rubbish regulations for the Village of Oreana, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oreana finds that it is in the best interests of the Village to amend Chapter 51;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE VOTE TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON MARCH 22, 2022 IN FAVOR OF THE PASSAGE OF THIS AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 51, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OREANA, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 51 is amended by adding 51.13 SERVICE AND PAYMENT REQUIRED:

§51.13 SERVICE AND PAYMENT REQUIRED.

All owners of residential and commercial premises in the village shall subscribe to and be a customer of the licensee for garbage, rubbish and recyclables removal for the residential or commercial area containing said premises and it shall be unlawful and a violation of this section for any such owner to fail at any time to be fully and lawfully entitled to receive garbage, rubbish and recyclables removal service from such licensee.

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Chapter 51 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION 5: The Village Clerk of the Village of Oreana shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village of Oreana this Ordinance Amending the Revised Code of Ordinances Specifically CHAPTER 51:13 SERVICE AND PAYMENT REQUIRED.
