

ORDINANCE NO 2026-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE PEORIA CITY CODE (1992) BY AMENDING SECTION 3-46 PERTAINING TO YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD, ESTABLISHMENT AND MEMBERSHIP, RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING RESOLUTION NUMBERS 2026-80 AND 2026-81, ADOPTED ON JUNE 2, 2026, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, FOR CLERICAL CORRECTIONS, AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS on June 2, 2026, the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria adopted Resolution 2025-80, appointing and reappointing members and alternate members to the Youth Advisory Board and setting the terms of office, and Resolution 2026-81, appointing Mariano Ortiz and Naureen Singh as the Council Youth Liaisons and establishing the terms of office, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain provisions or actions contemplated or undertaken pursuant to Resolution Nos 2026-80 and 2026-81 may not have been fully authorized by the existing Code of the City of Peoria at the time of their adoption, and

WHEREAS, to ensure the validity and enforceability of Resolution Nos 2026-80 and 2026-81 and all actions taken thereunder, it is necessary to amend the Code of the City of Peoria, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Mayor and Council to expand the opportunity for eligible youth to serve on the Youth Advisory Board and as Council Youth Liaisons, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Mayor and Council to formally ratify and confirm Resolution Nos 2026-80 and 2026-81 to ensure the continuity and legal validity of actions taken pursuant to and in reliance thereupon, in conjunction with the concurrent City Code amendment

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria as follows

SECTION 1 Amendment to City Code Chapter 3 of the Peoria City Code is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A

SECTION 2 Ratification and Confirmation of Resolution Nos 2026-80 and 2026-81 Resolution 2026-80 of the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, appointing and reappointing members to various Boards and Commissions and establishing the terms of office, and Resolution 2026-81 of the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, appointing Mariano Ortiz and Naureen Singh as Council Youth Liaisons and establishing the terms of

office, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved in all respects, and shall be effective upon the effective date of the concurrent City Code amendment

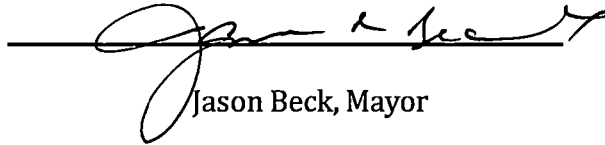
SECTION 3 Severability If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance

SECTION 4 Clerical Corrections The City Clerk is hereby authorized to correct typographical, clerical, and grammatical errors, if any, related to this Ordinance, and to make formatting changes appropriate for purposes of clarity, form, or consistency with the City Code Any such changes shall be in writing and approved by the City Attorney

SECTION 5 Effective Date This Ordinance shall become effective in the manner provided by law

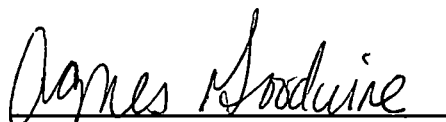

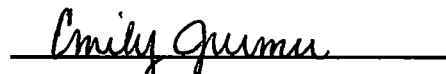

Amendments to the Peoria City Code, Chapter 3

HOW TO READ THIS DOCUMENT

Applicable sections of the City Code are denoted by **highlighted bold text** for ease of readability during the drafting process

Unless otherwise stated, provisions or regulations being deleted are shown in red strikethrough text or a line through the graphic, like this ~~Provisions that are being deleted are shown with a red strikethroughs text~~. Graphics containing red strikethrough are intended to remove the graphic in its entirety as well as any text that is embedded in the graphic

Provisions or regulations that are being added are shown in double-underlined blue text, like this Provisions that are being added are shown in double-underlined blue text. Graphics containing a double blue box are intended to add the graphic in its entirety as well as any text that is embedded in the graphic

Only those changes noted through the above methods for the specific sections and subsections of the City Code identified shall be made. When regulations, graphics or other text is omitted, or is shown unchanged in adjoining sections or subsections of the code, it shall remain unchanged

<u>Section 1</u> Amend Chapter 3 - Administration, Section 3-46 Youth Advisory Board, establishment and membership, only as follows, leaving all other sections and subsections not specifically referenced unchanged

Sec 3-46 Youth Advisory Board, establishment and membership

- (a) There is hereby created a Youth Advisory Board to be composed of ~~twenty-one(21)~~ twenty-three (23) regular members, all of whom shall be residents of the City or attend a school in Peoria
