AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 10-200 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Ethnic Intimidation And Institutional Vandalism," by adding a section prohibiting the display of symbols of racial animus, under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 10-200 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended as follows:

CHAPTER 10-200. ETHNIC INTIMIDATION AND INSTITUTIONAL VANDALISM.

* * *

§ 10-202. Prohibited Conduct.

- (1) No person shall commit the offense of ethnic intimidation and no person shall commit the offense of institutional vandalism.
- (2) No person shall display, with the intent to intimidate another person or to incite violence, in a place of employment, in a public accommodation, in a public facility, on public property or in the public right-of-way, the following symbols of virulent animus: a noose; a burning cross; or a swastika.

§ 10-203. Penalties.

(1) The penalty for violation of any provision of this Chapter is a fine of three hundred (300) dollars, except that a violation of subsection 10-202(2) is subject to the monetary fines established for a Class III offense and imprisonment of up to ninety (90) days.
