AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 9-605 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled 'Towing,' by increasing the amount of the fine that a towing company must pay for improper clean-up of an accident scene; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-605 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§9-605. Towing.

(14) Enforcement.

(b) Fines, Civil Penalties, and License Suspension.

(.1) Violations of this Section and any regulations promulgated under this Section shall be subject to the following civil penalties and license suspensions:
