AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 17-1300 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Philadelphia 21st Century Minimum Wage and Benefits Standard,” by revising provisions regarding waivers of minimum wage requirements, all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17-1300 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended as follows:

CHAPTER 17-1300. PHILADELPHIA 21ST CENTURY MINIMUM WAGE AND BENEFITS STANDARD.

§ 17-1304. Waivers.

The Office of Labor Standards may grant a partial or total waiver of these requirements, pursuant to the following:
