AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 34, "CITY POLICY," OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CODE **OF** ORDINANCES 34.107, **AMENDING SECTION** "POSITION **CLASSIFICATION** PLAN," BY RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN POSITIONS, BY CREATING NEW POSITIONS. **RETITLING CERTAIN** POSITIONS, AND RETITLING AND RECLASSIFYING **CERTAIN POSITIONS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY**; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 34.107, "Position Classification Plan," of Chapter 34, "City Policy," shall be amended as follows:

§ 34.107 POSITION CLASSIFICATION PLAN.

. . .

(C) There is hereby established a classification plan and complete inventory of all positions of city employees, providing for minimum and maximum salaries and intermediate salary steps in all ranges, and a salary plan in which each existing class of employment is assigned to one of the ranges in the plan.
