ORDINANCE NO. 10048 (NS)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 812.207 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO ACTS PROHIBITED ON TRAILS AND PATHWAYS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that it is necessary to amend County Code section 812.207 to make it consistent with changes that were previously made to Title 6 of the County Code and to add a provision to protect County trails and pathways from damage or destruction.

Section 2. Section 812.207 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 812.207. ACTS PROHIBITED ON TRAILS AND PATHWAYS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the following conduct on a trail or pathway:

- (a) [No change.]
- (b) Dig or plow without the prior written authorization of the County Official;
- (c) [No change.]
- (d) Carry a lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette or other smoking device, containing tobacco or any other substance, or light a pipe, cigar or cigarette or other smoking device, containing tobacco or any other substance;
 - (e) Cause or allow a dog to be "at large" as defined in County Code Section62.602(c);
 - (f) [No change.]
 - (g) [No change.]
 - (h) [No change.]
 - (i) [No change.]
- (j) Leave or deposit any waste paper, metal cans, plastic or glass bottles, used smoking material or any other trash;
 - (k) [No change.]
 - (l) [No change.]

(m) Mark, deface, disfigure, destroy, damage, remove or tamper with any vegetation, natural material or improvements without the prior written approval of the Director of Parks and Recreation or the Director's designee.

The prohibition in subparagraph (a) above does not apply to emergency or law enforcement vehicles, trail maintenance vehicles and equipment, or motorized wheelchairs.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in the <u>San Diego Commerce</u>, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
