

**Ordinance No. 10573 (N.S.)**

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 33.104.1 OF THE  
SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES  
TO RESTRICT TARGET SHOOTING NEAR DONOHOE MOUNTAIN  
IN THE DULZURA AREA

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances should be revised to include a section addressing target shooting near Donohoe Mountain in the Dulzura area. This new section will restrict the discharge of firearms at any mark or target, other than legal game or wildlife, except for in defense of person or property in two designated areas known for target shooting activity. This closure will remain in effect year-round, helping to reduce the ongoing threat of wildfire and increase public safety in the area.

Section 2. Section 33.104.1 is hereby added to the San Diego County Regulatory Code as follows:

**SEC. 33.104.1. TARGET SHOOTING PROHIBITED**

Other than in the defense of person or property, it shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, fire or discharge at any mark or target, other than legal game or wildlife, with any pistol, revolver, shotgun, rifle or any other firearm or device fired or discharged by explosives, or air gun or air rifle in any portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of San Diego, lying within that portion of said County described as follows:

Those portions of Sections 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 and 16, Township 18 South, Range 2 East, San Bernardino Meridian lying in the County of San Diego, State of California described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Section 9; Thence easterly along the south line of said Section 9 to the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of said Section 16; Thence southerly along west line of said northeast quarter to the southwest corner of the north 30 acres of said northeast quarter of the northwest quarter; Thence easterly along the south line of said north 30 acres of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter to the southeast corner thereof; Thence northerly along the east line of said northeast quarter of the northwest quarter to the northeast corner thereof; Thence easterly along said south line of Section 9 to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 9; Thence northerly along the west line of said southeast quarter of the southeast quarter to the northwest corner thereof; Thence easterly along the north line of said southeast quarter of the southeast quarter to the northeast corner thereof; Thence northerly along the east line of said Section 9 to the intersection with the northwesterly right-of-way line of Marron Valley Road (also known as Cottonwood Creek Road); Thence northeasterly along said northwesterly right-of-way line to the intersection with the south line of the northerly 1034.97 feet of the easterly 491.00 feet of the southwest quarter of southwest quarter of said Section 3; Thence westerly along said south line to the westerly line of said northerly 1034.97 feet of the easterly 491.00 feet to the southwest corner thereof;

Thence northerly along the west line of said northerly 1034.97 feet of the easterly 491.00 feet to the northwest corner thereof; Thence westerly along the north line of said southwest quarter of the southwest quarter to the northwest corner thereof; Thence westerly along the north line of southeast quarter of the southeast quarter and the north line of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 4 to the northwest corner of said southwest quarter of the southeast quarter; Thence southerly along the west line of said southwest one quarter of the southeast quarter to the southwest corner thereof; Thence westerly along the north line of said Section 9 to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said Section 9; Thence southerly along the east line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter to the southeast corner thereof; Thence westerly along the south line of said northwest one quarter of the northwest quarter to the southwest corner thereof; Thence continuing westerly along the north line the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 8 to the northwest corner of said southwest quarter of the northeast quarter; Thence southerly along the west line of said southwest quarter of the northeast quarter to the southwest corner thereof; Thence southeasterly in a straight line to the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 8; Thence easterly along the north line of said southeast one quarter of the southeast quarter to the northeast corner thereof; Thence southerly along west line of said Section 8 to the Point of Beginning.

TOGETHER WITH:

That portion of Rancho Jamul and those portions of Sections 4 and 5, Township 18 South, Range 2 East, San Bernardino Meridian lying in the County of San Diego, State of California described as follows: Beginning at a point on the centerline of State Highway 94 that lies 2,000.00 feet northwesterly, measured along said centerline, of the intersection of said Highway 94 and Otay Truck Trail; Thence southwesterly in a straight line to a point on the Rancho Jamul boundary that is the corner common to Lots 1 and 2 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 2 East, San Bernardino Meridian; Thence southeasterly along said boundary of Rancho Jamul to corner number 7 thereof, also being the northwest corner of said Section 5; Thence southerly along the west line of said Section 5 to the southwesterly corner of the northwesterly quarter of the southwest quarter thereof; Thence easterly along the south line of said northwesterly quarter, the south line of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter, the south line of northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the south line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter, all in said Section 5, to the southeast corner of said northeast quarter of the southeast quarter; Thence continuing easterly along the south line of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section 4 to the southeast corner of said northwest quarter of the southwest quarter; Thence northerly along the east line of said northwest quarter and the east line of southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the east line of government Lot 4, all in said Section 4 to the southwest corner of Parcel 1 as shown on Record of Survey 17519 recorded on August 30, 2002 as instrument no. 2002-0742915, records of San Diego County, California; Thence northerly along the west line said Parcel 1 and the west line of Parcel 2 as shown on said record of Survey 17519 to the centerline of said State Highway 94; Thence northwesterly along the centerline of said

State Highway 94 to the Point of Beginning. Excepting therefrom any portion lying within the right-of-way of State Highway 94.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in The Daily Transcript, a publication of general circulation in the County of San Diego.
