ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 72.243.26.3. OF THE SAN DIEGO  
COUNTY CODE ESTABLISHING A WEIGHT LIMIT ON COUNTY  
MAINTAINED ROADS IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 72.243.26.3. of the San Diego County Code is hereby added:

Section 72.243.26.3. RAMONA. Except as otherwise permitted by law, the maximum gross weight of any commercial vehicle operating on Highland Valley Road between Archie Moore Road and Bandy Canyon Road shall not exceed fourteen thousand pounds. The route which shall remain unrestricted by any local regulation as to commercial vehicles so long as this section shall remain in effect is as follows: State Route 67 to State Route 78.
