

**ORDINANCE NO. 10755 (N.S.)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISION 4 OF TITLE 3 AND DIVISION 10 OF TITLE 6 OF THE SAN DIEGO REGULATORY CODE RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY, MORALS AND WELFARE AND AMBULANCE, CRITICAL CARE, AND NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.**

Section 1. Chapter 1 of Division 4 of Title 3 of the San Diego County Regulatory Code is amended to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 1. [RESERVED]**

Section 2. Section 610.804 of Chapter 8 of Division 10 of Title 6 of the San Diego County Regulatory Code is amended to read as follows:

**SEC. 610.804. INSURANCE.**


Every applicant for a Non-Emergency Transport Providers Permit shall obtain and maintain in full force and effect liability insurance, including, but not limited to, comprehensive auto liability, in an amount and coverage type determined by the County's risk manager to be adequate.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in The Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
