

ORDINANCE NO. 8965 (N.S.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 82.32 AND 82.35  
OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
RELATING TO TERMS OF OFFICE OF PAST GRAND JURORS ASSOCIATION  
IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW COMMITTEE MEMEBERS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that it would allow the Past Grand Jurors Association Implementation Review Committee to better fulfill its duties and responsibilities if members of the Implementation Review Committee served on a calendar year basis instead of on a fiscal year basis. The amendments made by this ordinance are intended to change the term of service of Implementation Review Committee members from their current fiscal year basis to a calendar year basis.

Section 2. Section 82.32 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 82.32. TERMS OF OFFICE. Each member shall serve a term of two (2) years beginning January 1 and ending December 31, two years later. The terms of four (4) members of the Implementation Review Committee shall expire in even numbered years, and the terms of three (3) members of the Implementation Review Committee shall expire in odd numbered years. A member shall be appointed for not more than two (2) consecutive terms. A term for this purpose shall not include service in the unexpired term of a member being replaced.

Section 3. The members of the Implementation Review Committee holding office on the effective date of this ordinance shall continue to hold their offices until the December 31 following the date when their terms would have otherwise expired.

Section 4. Section 82.35 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 82.35. ORGANIZATION. The Implementation Review Committee shall select annually from its membership a Chairperson and Vice Chairperson. The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson shall serve a one year term beginning on January 1

or the date of their selection, whichever is later, and ending on December 31 of the same year. A majority of members currently appointed to the Implementation Review Committee shall constitute a quorum. The Implementation Review Committee shall keep written minutes of its meetings, a copy of which should be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and with the Chief Administrative Officer. The Implementation Review Committee shall establish a meeting schedule and shall give public notice of the time and place of its meetings. All meetings of the committee shall be open to the public and all persons shall be permitted to attend any meetings of the committee.

Section 5. The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson serving on the effective date of this ordinance shall continue to hold the positions of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson until December 31, 1999.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in the

San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
