

ORDINANCE NO. 9270
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 455 (f) OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO INACTIVE WASTE SITE
MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 455(f) of the San Diego County Administrative Code is amended to read:

Solid Waste Management

(1) Control and manage all County owned or leased real property necessary to the management of the County's closed and inactive solid waste disposal facilities.

- (a) Protect human health and the environment.
- (b) Comply with Federal, State, and local regulations.
- (c) Maintain sites using best management practices.
- (d) Maximize the rate of return on all assets.

(2) Provide countywide solid waste planning and management functions

- (a) Manage AB 939 related waste reduction and recycling components of the County's Integrated Waste Management Plan.
- (c) Manage 29 County Non-exclusive Solid Waste Management Agreements (Franchise Agreements)
- (d) Prepare appropriate sections of the San Diego County Waste Management Plan as required.

This Ordinance to become operative on January 1, 2001.
