## ORDINANCE NO. <u>9381</u> (NEW SERIES)

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO THE PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW BOARD

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the following amendments of the San Diego County Administrative Code will provide for adequate staffing to maintain a weekly meeting schedule of the Planning and Environmental Review Board.

Section 2. Section 376 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 376. RECOGNITION OF PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW BOARD.

There is in the County a Planning and Environmental Review Board, hereafter in this Article referred to as the "Review Board." The Review Board shall be an advisory agency as that term is defined in the Subdivision Map Act.

Section 3. Section 376.2 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Section 376.2. MEMBERSHIP OF REVIEW BOARD.

The Review Board shall consist of three members as follows:

- 1. Planner member, first, second and third alternates nominated by Director of Department of Planning and Land Use.
- 2. Engineer member, first, second and third alternates nominated by Director of Public Works.
- 3. Environmental member, first, second and third alternates jointly nominated by Directors of Planning and Land Use and Public Works.

The members and first, second and third alternates shall be appropriately qualified County employees. Nominations shall be approved by the Chief Administrative Officers and forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for appointment. Said appointment to be made in an open public meeting of the Board of Supervisors.

The first alternate shall serve in place of the member in the event of a member's disqualification from voting, or in a member's absence. The second alternate shall serve in the event that the first alternate is disqualified from voting or is absent. The third alternate shall serve in the event that the second alternate is disqualified from voting or is absent. The members and alternates shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors until any replacement appointment becomes effective.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen (15) days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the San Diego Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
