

ORDINANCE NO. 9394

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 249 TO ARTICLE XV-B OF
THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
RELATING TO TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES FEES –
AGING & INDEPENDENCE SERVICES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Add Section 249 to Article XV-B of the San Diego County Administrative Code to read as follows:

SEC. 249. TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES FEES – AGING AND INDEPENDENCE SERVICES

(a) The Director shall charge and collect a fee established in accordance with the State Targeted Case Management (TCM) Cost Plan process for Aging & Independence Services Targeted Case Management Services. The fees to be charged shall be calculated based on adjusted gross income exceeding the California Supplemental Security Income (SSI) rate of \$712.00 per month for individuals and \$1,265.00 per month for couples. The following fee schedules are based on the family size and adjusted gross income of the party liable for the fee:

FEE SCHEDULE – INDIVIDUAL OR FAMILY OF TWO

For families of one or two persons, including the client and all members of the same household:

<u>PERCENT OF SSI RATE</u>	<u>INDIVIDUAL MONTHLY INCOME</u>	<u>COUPLE MONTHLY INCOME</u>	<u>HOURLY CHARGE FOR CASE MANAGEMENT</u>
300%	\$2,136	\$3,795	\$15.00
400%	\$2,848	\$5,060	\$30.00
500%	\$3,560	\$6,325	\$45.00

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen (15) days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
