## ORDINANCE NO. 9438 (New Series)

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 81.102.15 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PUBLIC ROAD STANDARDS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 81.102.15 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 81.102.15. "SAN DIEGO COUNTY STANDARDS" refers to those standards and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors as Document Numbers 635855A, 635855B, 644855C, 748505A, and Document Number 767412; provided, however, that with respect to development within the "County Town" area of the Borrego Springs Planning Area, the standards and specifications contained in the "Community Right-of-Way Development Standards - Country Town Area of the Borrego Springs Planning Area" on file with the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors as Document Number 740149, and with respect to development within the San Dieguito Planning Area the standards and specifications contained in the "Community Right-of-Way Development Standards - Country Town Sphere of the San Dieguito Planning Area" on file with the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors as Document Number 750029(a), and with respect to development within the Fallbrook Community Development Area, the standards and specifications contained in the "Fallbrook Community Right-of-Way Development Standards for Public Roads" on file with the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors as Document Number 761748, and with respect to development within the Julian Community Planning Area, the standards and specifications contained in the "Community Right-of-Way Development Standards: Julian Historic District and Julian Community Planning Area" on file with the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors as Document Number 0768777 shall also apply and shall supercede the aforementioned documents to the extent of any conflict between them.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after 30 days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary thereof shall be published in the <u>San Diego Commerce</u>, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
