

ORDINANCE NO. 9566_(N.S.)

FIRST CONSIDERATION OF AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 365
TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ESTABLISHING
DISTRICT ATTORNEY FEES AND CHARGES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the District Attorney's Office incurs non-recoverable costs when it provides certain services. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish fees and charges so that this office can recover actual costs incurred in providing such services.

Section 2. Section 365 of Article XX of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby established to read as follows:

SECTION 365 DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

The following fees and charges shall be paid to the San Diego County District Attorney's Office or the County collection agent.

- (a) A fee of \$35.50 for a level one background investigation.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in a publication of general published in the County of San Diego.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
