

ORDINANCE NO. 9584

AN ORDINANCE OF THE  
SAN DIEGO COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT  
RELATING TO ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego, acting as and constituting the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Flood Control District, ordains as follows:

Section 1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to appoint and authorize the Director, Department of Public Works or his designee, as Flood Control District Officer and Engineer to perform functions including, but not limited to negotiation, execution and amendment of encroachment agreements on behalf of the San Diego County Flood Control District.

Section 2. ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENTS. The Director, Department of Public Works (Director), is authorized to enter into an encroachment agreement with a property owner upon determination that the encroachment may be allowed in a Flood Control District easement. The purpose of an encroachment agreement with the San Diego County Flood Control District is to ensure any encroachment allowed by the District is in accordance with conditions of the District. The Director is appointed and authorized to perform functions related to encroachment agreements including, but not limited to negotiation, execution and amendment, on behalf of the Flood Control District.
