ORDINANCE NO 9717 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 250 TO ARTICLE XV-B OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RESIDENT USER FEE IN COUNTY SERVICE AREA 69

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that there is a need to establish a resident user fee for emergency medical services provided by County Service Area 69. This ordinance will allow the County to charge said fee.

Section 2. Section 250 is hereby added to the San Diego County Administrative Code Article XV-B to read as follows:

SEC. 250. COUNTY SERVICE AREA 69 RESIDENT USER FEE.

A fee of \$575 shall be charged to residents of County Service Area 69 who are transported to a hospital by a County Service Area 69 provider.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on July 1, 2005, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
