

**ORDINANCE NO. 9727 (N.S.)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 64.206 OF THE COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES RELATING TO VECTOR CONTROL**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose --This ordinance corrects a typographical error affecting a cross- reference in the Vector Control provisions of the County Code.

Section 2. Section 64.206 of the County Code is amended to read as follows:

**SEC. 64.206. PENALTY**

Any person who creates, allows or maintains a public nuisance as defined by Section 64.204 of this code is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of \$1 000 or six months in jail or both.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of he members of this Board voting for and against it in the San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
