AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN LAKE SAN MARCOS VILLAGE REF: R04-002

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Mitigated Negative Declaration dated August 25, 2005 on file with DPLU as Environmental Review No. 04-08-002; is hereby adopted.

It is hereby found that the use or development permitted by the application is consistent with the provisions of the Resource Protection Ordinance.

The Fish and Game Fees have been paid in the amount of \$1,275 for the review of the Mitigated Negative Declaration, Receipt number 238498, dated paid June 16, 2005.

Section 2. The zoning classification of the real property described below is hereby changed as follows:

The existing zoning classification is as follows:

OLD ZONE: Use Regulations <u>C36</u>, Animal Designator <u>Q</u>, Density <u>40</u>, Lot <u>Size-</u>, Building Type <u>W</u>, Maximum Floor Area <u>-</u>, Floor Area Ratio <u>-</u>, Height <u>G</u>, Lot Coverage <u>-</u> Setbacks O, Open Space A, Special Area Regulations-.

The zoning classification is changed to read as follows:

NEW ZONE: Use Regulations <u>C34</u>, Animal Designator <u>Q</u>, Density <u>40</u>, Lot Size <u>-</u>, Building Type <u>L</u>, Maximum Floor Area <u>-</u>, Floor Area Ratio <u>-</u>, Height <u>M</u>, Lot Coverage <u>-</u>, Setbacks <u>O</u>, Open Space <u>A</u>, Special Area Regulations <u>-</u>.

Description of affected real property:

Lot 1 of Lake San Marcos Village, in the County of San Diego, State of California, according to map thereof No. 8742, filed in the office of the County Recorder of San County, on December 16, 1977, a certificate of correction thereto recorded November 7, 1979 as File No. 79-470262, of official records.
