## ORDINANCE NO. 9903 (NEW SERIES)

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 72.123. OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 72.123. of the San Diego County Code is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 72.123. PARKING FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES PROHIBITED.

No person shall park vehicle upon any highway for the principal purpose of:

- (a) Displaying such vehicle for sale. A vehicle shall not be considered to be displayed for sale when it is parked upon any highway if the vehicle contains a for sale sign not greater than eight and one-half inches (8 ½") by eleven inches (11") and the sign is placed on a side window, and the vehicle is not parked within 500 feet of other vehicles advertised for sale.
- (b) Washing, greasing, or repairing such vehicle except repairs necessitated by an emergency.
