

ORDINANCE NO. 9990 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 9128 (NEW SERIES)  
PROVIDING A PROCEDURE FOR FIXING AND COLLECTING CHARGES ON  
THE TAX ROLL FOR SERVICES AND CONTINUING IN EFFECT THE  
PREVIOUSLY APPROVED MAXIMUM CHARGE WITHIN SAN DIEGO  
COUNTYWIDE PERMANENT ROAD DIVISION NO. 1000, ZONE NO. 1004 –  
BUTTERFLY LANE.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego, acting on behalf of San Diego  
Countywide Permanent Road Division No. 1000, Zone No. 1004 – Butterfly Lane  
ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 9128 providing a procedure for fixing and collecting  
charges on the tax roll for road services provided by San Diego Countywide Permanent  
Road Division No. 1000, Zone No 1004 – Butterfly Lane is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty  
(30) days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage,  
a summary shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against  
the same in the San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in  
the County of San Diego.
