ORDINANCE NO 9995 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF VITAL RECORDS AND STATISTICS FEES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. A new Section 252 is hereby added to ARTICLE XV-B of the County of San Diego Administrative Code to read as follows:

SEC. 252. OFFICE OF VITAL RECORDS AND STATISTICS - FEE FOR STATE MANDATED MEDICAL MARIJUANA IDENTIFICATION CARD PROGRAM

The Director shall charge and collect the following fees to be charged annually to all initial applicants and renewal applicants for the State Mandated Medical Marijuana Identification Card:

Medical Marijuana Identification Card \$166.00

\$83.00

Reduced Fee for Medical Marijuana
Identification Card for Medi-Cal Beneficiaries

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
