

ORDINANCE: 24-21

PASSED: May 6, 2024

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARTIES, OTHER THAN THE VILLAGE'S AUTHORIZED RECYCLING CONTRACTOR, FROM REMOVING RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WHEN THE ITEMS HAVE BEEN PLACED AT THE DESIGNATED COLLECTION LOCATION WITHIN THE VILLAGE'S PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCERVILLE, ALLEN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO; to-wit:

SECTION ONE: That, upon placement of recyclable waste materials by residential customers, at the designated recycling collection location, which is located at or near the edge of the pavement within the public rights-of-way, said recyclable materials shall become the property of and shall only be collected by the Village's authorized residential recyclable waste contractor, and/or their authorized representative.

SECTION TWO: During the twenty-four (24) hour period commencing at 6:00 p.m. on any day preceding the day designated for collection of recyclable waste materials, no person, other than the Village's authorized recycling contractor, and/or their authorized representative, shall remove recyclable waste materials which have been placed at the designated recycling collection location.

SECTION THREE: Any, and each, collection in violation hereof from one (1) or more designated recycling collection locations during such twenty-four (24) hour period shall constitute a separate offense and be subject to a minor misdemeanor and a one-hundred dollar and no cents (\$100.00) fine, plus applicable court costs.

SECTION FOUR: Nothing in this Ordinance shall limit the right of an individual, organization or other entity, to donate, sell or otherwise dispose of recyclable waste materials, provided that any such disposal is in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.
