

ORDINANCE: 25-03

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING, AND ENACTING AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING'S VILLAGE OF SPENCERVILLE CUSTOM CODE BOOK AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SPENCERVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation prepared and published a Code of Ordinances for the Village of Spencerville and,

WHEREAS, the Village needs to approve, adopt, and enact the Custom Code Book of Ordinances for the Village of Spencerville as prepared by American Legal Publishing.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCERVILLE, OHIO:

SECTION ONE: American Legal publishing's Village of Spencerville Custom Code Book, as reviewed and approved by the Legislative Authority, is hereby adopted and enacted. Any prior version which may have been previously adopted by the municipality is hereby repealed as obsolete and is hereby replaced in its entirety by this Village of Spencerville Custom Code Book.

SECTION TWO: One copy of American Legal Publishing's Village of Spencerville Custom Code Book certified as corrected by the Mayor and Clerk of Legislative Authority, as required by Ohio Revised Code § 731.23, shall be kept in its initial form on file in the office of the Clerk of the municipality and retained as a permanent ordinance record of the municipality. The Clerk of the municipality is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the Code of Ordinances as required by Ohio Revised Code § 731.23.

SECTION THREE: All ordinances and resolutions of parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the Village of Spencerville Custom Code Book as adopted in section one hereof, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance, except as follows:


- (A) The enactment of the Village of Spencerville Custom Code Book, shall not be constructed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of enactment, or an action proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, nor to affect an indictment or prosecution therefore. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of the revision and codification.
- (B) The repeal provided above shall not affect:
 - (1) The grant or creation of a franchise, license, right, easement or privilege;
 - (2) The purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property;

- (3) The appropriation or expenditure of any money or promise or guarantee of payment;
- (4) The assumption of any contract or obligation;
- (5) The issuance and delivery of any bonds, obligations, or other instruments of indebtedness;
- (6) The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments or charges;
- (7) The establishment, naming, vacating or grade level of any street or public way;
- (8) The dedication of property or plat approval;
- (9) The annexation or detachment of territory;
- (10) Any legislation enacted subsequent to the adoption of this ordinance;
- (11) Any legislation specifically superseding the provision of the Village of Spencerville Custom Code book.


SECTION FOUR: Whenever reference is made in any documents, publications, or signs of the municipality, including but not limited to traffic tickets and traffic-control signs, to a section as it existed in a former edition of the Ohio Basic Code, the reference shall extend and apply to the section referred to as subsequently amended, revised, recodified, or renumbered.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
