Ordinance No. 2023 - 18

AN ORDINANCE Amending Chapter 32, paragraph 32.081, City Treasurer Compensation, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS
THIS 3RD DAY OF APRIL 2023

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, has authority to adopt ordinances and promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Chapter 32 of the Code of Ordinances and determined that it requires certain amendments to encourage effective management funds City funds; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy has duly considered the matter and has concluded that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to provide proper compensation for an individual serving the City of Troy as the Deputy Treasurer.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois.

SECTION 2: That *Chapter 32.081 (Compensation)* of the Troy Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to include the provision described in Exhibit A.


SECTION 4: That if any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the City Council.

CHAPTER 32 – THE CITY TREASURER

Chapter 32-081 – COMPENSATION

The City Treasurer shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of \$7,500 annually for the 12-month period beginning May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the City Treasurer for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023; May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024; and May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025. The City Treasurer's salary shall be paid to the City Treasurer in 12 equal monthly installments.

The City Deputy Treasurer, if a current city employee, shall receive a seventy-five cents (\$0.75) premium per hour, which will be added to the employee's base pay.
